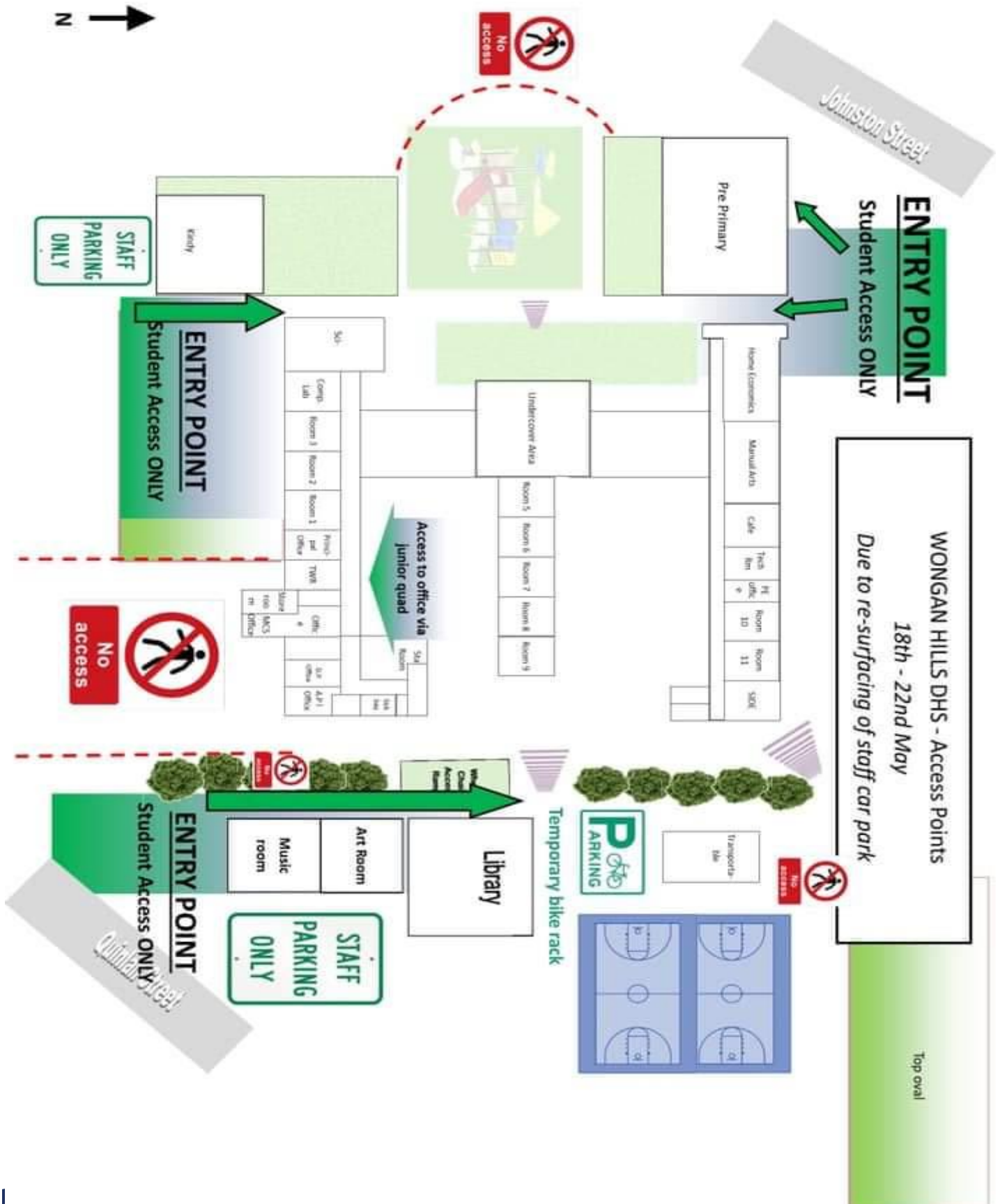

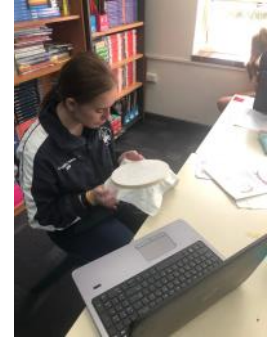
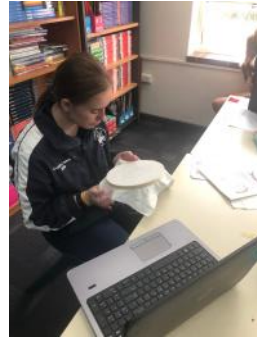
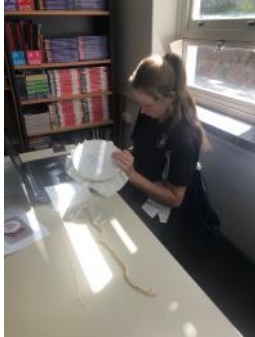
Crafty Option
